



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

EXCELLENCE IN LOW MORTALITY RATES

Carle's low mortality is ranked in the top quartile when compared to the 150-plus hospitals that participate in Premier health alliance's Quest initiative. Carle's mortality rate shows fewer actual deaths than expected based on clinical outcomes. That means for every 164 patients, 63 lived when they weren't expected to, according to a study of 4,811 eligible discharges.

Thanks to the dedication of our physicians and clinical staff and to our efforts to improve quality at every level – from adherence to the Core Measures to practicing medication reconciliation – we are helping our patients enjoy the best outcomes.

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



Carle's long-term goal is not only to treat illness and injury but also to prevent it. In 2009, Carle helped thousands of kids in Champaign County and beyond to avoid injuries and stay healthy.

Last year more than 36,600 children learned about everything from ATV to water safety through Risk Watch, Playing It Safe and the Carle Center for Rural Health and Farm Safety programs. The initiatives targeted children in both rural and urban areas and used interactive activities to drive the message home.

A focus area has been hand hygiene, which is the single best way to protect against the spread of infections. At 83 percent, our compliance rates have consistently improved over the past year and far exceed the national average of 48 percent.
