# General information for Patients and Families



#### Standards of Care for Providers Listed in this Directory

Providers listed in this directory have pledged to follow the Carle Transgender Standards of Care, which means, in part, that they recognize and respect self-identities. They also agree to take on extra training for LGBTQ+ friendly care. We're committed to providing affirming care. Please feel comfortable reminding us of your name and pronouns if we don't get it right. It's our desire – and duty – to get it right.

#### Preventive Health Screenings for Gender-Diverse Patients

If you have a particular body part or organ, and otherwise meet criteria, the usual preventive health screenings should be done for it. For example, trans men with a cervix should receive Pap smears starting at age 21. Trans women should discuss prostate screening with their provider starting at age 55. You can trust the providers in this directory to conduct screenings with the sensitivity you deserve.

#### Care Outside of the Traditional Environment at Carle

The Carle Mobile Health Clinic brings affordable, non-urgent primary care services to neighborhoods near you, including chronic condition management and education, treatment of acute illness, wellness care, and lab testing. Check out carle.org/MobileHealthClinic or call (217) 365-7928 for times and locations near you.

Carle also offers **virtual visits** for some types of care, which allow you to see and hear your Carle provider from anywhere (for example, by computer or phone). Check with your provider to see if virtual visits may be an option for you.

#### Care for Gender-Diverse Teens

Some of the providers listed in this directory will prescribe gender-affirming hormone therapy (GAHT) to older teens or refer them to an endocrinologist who may prescribe GAHT to the teen. Youth under the age of 18 require parental consent for GAHT. By Illinois law, minors age 12 and older have the right to keep their discussions with healthcare providers confidential [Statutes 410 ILCS 210, 405 ILCS 5, PA 102-0685].

#### Updating Gender and Name Preferences in Your Electronic Health Record

Carle patients can update their name and gender identity whenever they like through the MyCarle patient portal. Sign up for access at MyCarle.com or download the app to your phone. Once you're in the portal, navigate to Account Settings  $\rightarrow$  Personal Information.

#### For Family Members and Loved Ones of People Who Are Gender Diverse

For those with a loved one who's transgender or gender diverse, this can be a confusing and challenging change to your life and to the lives of those around you. Many loved ones of people who are gender diverse experience emotions such as shock, grief or even anger. It's normal to feel confused and conflicted at the loss of your loved one's previous identity while adjusting to their new one.

Carle and the therapists listed in this directory would be glad to help you work through these feelings, which can allow you to more fully accept the new identity of your loved one. You can also speak to your primary care provider about a referral to Carle Behavioral Health Service, or speak to a social worker in your primary care provider's office to get connected to a local therapist.

#### Suicide/Mental Health Hotline

**Call, text or chat the number 988.** This three-digit number gives you (or your loved ones) 24/7 access to trained crisis counselors who can help people experiencing suicidal, substance use and/or mental health crises – or any other kind of emotional distress. People can also dial 988 if they're worried about a loved one who may need crisis support.

988 doesn't send a person's geolocation to police or EMS. If someone's life is in immediate danger, call 911.
