As a new patient, you will meet with a social worker who will provide information on services that can help you through treatment. We can help with any assistance you need now, and we will give you our contact information so you can call if you have concerns in the future.

Your social worker can assist with:

Transportation to and from appointments

Prescription assistance

Financial assistance

In-home help

Free wigs and hats

Family Medical Leave of Absence (FMLA)

Social Security Disability or SSI

Medicare and Medicaid issues

Care Planning (home care, assisted living, nursing home, hospice)

Advance Directives (health care power of attorney)

Anything else you need help with

Social workers also facilitate Carle Cancer Center's nine support groups for patients and caregivers. We can provide short-term counseling to help patients and families cope with diagnosis and treatment, and we are available to provide ongoing emotional support. If needed, we can make referrals to outside counseling services.

ARRIVING FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT

Patient and visitors may park in the North or South Parking Garages ([see map on opposite side for locations](#)). Parking fees are posted at each garage entrance. For frequent patients and visitors, Carle offers two types of discount parking:

- **Discount parking passes:**

Valid for any 24-hour period with no limit on entry and exit.

A book of five passes can be purchased for \$12.50.

- **Discount punch card:**

Valid for 30 free exits with no expiration date. The discount punch card can be purchased for \$30.

Both passes are available for purchase at the Hospital Cashier's Office in the Main Orchard Street Lobby, at Arabella Boutique on the first floor of Carle Cancer Center or at the Security Control Center after hours. For more information, please call the Hospital Cashier's Office at (217) 383-3033.

Free parking is also available at the Champaign County Fairgrounds (see map for location). Carle offers free shuttle service to and from South and North Clinics from 5 a.m. – 9 pm., Monday – Friday (excluding major holidays).

Valet parking is available at the circle drive of Carle Cancer Center/Mills Breast Cancer Institute.

PREPARING FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT

Some helpful tips when coming to Carle Cancer Center for your appointment:

- Try to arrive 15 minutes prior to your appointment time
- Bring your insurance information and a list of all of the medications you are currently taking
- Have a friend or family member come with you to support you and take notes throughout your appointment
- Write down any questions you have ahead of time so you don't forget them
- Fill out and bring the consult form provided
